The "Freedom Seat" raised toilet seat has proven to be a very successful part of our accessibility improvement program at Hyatt Hotels Corporation over the past four years. Early on in our program, we elected to use the "Freedom Seat" rather than a raised toilet fixture in our typical guest room accessibility retrofits. The "Freedom Seat" provides a greater level of accessibility than a permanently raised fixture. Guests who require a standard height toilet seat can be accommodated as well as those guests who prefer a raised seat.

In addition, the optional removable assist arms which we specified with the "Freedom Seat" are preferred by some of our guests who have difficulty using the standard wall mounted grab bars. Again, the level of accessibility is improved by offering a greater choice of assistive devices.

The mounting mechanism of the seat allows our staff to mount or de-mount the seat in a matter of minutes, allowing us to be very responsive to our guest's particular accessibility requirements.

We have been very happy with the "Freedom Seat", and recommend it to any hotel that wishes to offer improved accessibility to its guests.
